

FUNDRAISING POLICY

To offset diving costs i.e. equipment and other projects, the Pan Am Diving Club requires each family to raise funds to support the Club initiatives. Fundraising this year has two aspects Mandatory and Optional.

MANDATORY

- Each competitive member is responsible for payment through the 3 mandatory fundraisers which total \$300.00. The three events are:
- Fort Whyte- September/October 2009
- IMAX- November 2010
- Rumors/Silent Auction –February 2010

Tickets will be distributed.

All of these fundraisers have proven to be highly successful and both IMAX and Rumors have been great fun for the families.

OPTIONAL:

The following fundraisers provide an opportunity for families to raise money that allows for a percentage to be placed in their athletes account.

For each dollar raised 50% is the split between the club and the family.

Volunteer Policy

The Pan Am Diving Club has a history of generous, warm-hearted family volunteer participation. Fundraising and volunteer commitments will be monitored and recorded by the Parent Liaison member of the Board of Directors.

The Pan Am Diving Club hosts approximately 2-4 diving competitions each year. To evenly distribute the volunteer hours among all families, the Club requires each family to volunteer their time to help run these competitions. Competitive A and B families will be required to volunteer a minimum of **55** hours per year and the Pre Competitive families will be required to volunteer a minimum of **35** hours per year. Super Tots will be required to volunteer **25** hours. **In order to assure a full refund at the end of the season, it is the responsibility of the family member to co-ordinate with the Volunteer Co-coordinator to ensure that credit hours have been recorded to their account.**

Several weeks prior to a competition, a volunteer activity form will be forwarded to each family. Refer to chart #1. Please complete the form as soon as possible and return it to the coordinator of volunteers for the event. Your choices for time slots, activities, etc. will be honoured on a first come first serve basis. (Volunteers receive training/information and support as necessary to successfully carry out Volunteer duties.)

Volunteer hours, to a minimum of **55** hours (for Competitive A and B) and or **35** hours (for Pre Competitive), may be used towards your volunteer commitment. Super Tots are required to do **25** hours of volunteer work.

Other ways to meet your volunteer commitment (each is worth 15 volunteer credit hours)

- Holding a Club Board Executive position and attending **80% of meetings** held by the club
- Organizing a diving competition or a successful fundraising event
- Organizing registration, scoring, hospitality, or marketing/sales for competitions
